

## SAFE WORK METHOD STATEMENT

**Note:** Work must be performed in accordance with this safe work method statement (SWMS). This SWMS must be kept and be available for inspection until the high risk construction work to which this SWMS relates is completed. If the SWMS is revised, every version should be kept. If a notifiable incident occurs in relation to the high risk construction work in this SWMS, the SWMS must be kept for at least 2 years from the date of the notifiable incident.

High risk construction work:

- Risk of a person falling more than 2 metres (note: in some jurisdictions this is 3 metres)
- Work on a telecommunication tower
- Likely to involve disturbing asbestos
- Work in or near a confined space
- Use of explosives
- Work on or near chemical, fuel or refrigerant lines
- Work in an area that may have a contaminated or flammable atmosphere
- Work on, in or adjacent to a road, railway, shipping lane or other traffic corridor in use by traffic other than pedestrians
- Work in an area with movement of powered mobile plant
- Work in or near water or other liquid that involves a risk of drowning
- Demolition of load-bearing structure
- Temporary load-bearing support for structural alterations or repairs
- Work in or near a shaft or trench deeper than 1.5 m or a tunnel
- Work on or near pressurised gas mains or piping
- Work on or near energised electrical installations or services
- Tilt-up or precast concrete elements
- Work in areas with artificial extremes of temperature
- Diving work
